Jonathon Welch AM pays tribute to the music and life of Sir Harry Secombe

Don't miss ARIA, Logie and Helpmann award winner **Jonathon Welch AM** when he takes to the RPAC stage for the first time to pay tribute to the life and music of one of the most popular Welsh tenors and comedian, **Sir Harry Secombe.**

Jonathon made his debut with **Dame Joan Sutherland** at the Sydney Opera House in the "Merry Widow" (1988) for Opera Australia and has since performed extensively alongside many of the world's greatest singers, directors and conductors including **kd Lang**, **Baz Lurhmann** and **Richard Bonynge**. He is most recently known for his work creating choirs for the homeless and disadvantaged in Australia and was the subject of an internationally acclaimed, award-winning TV documentary "Choir of Hard Knocks".

Regarded as one of the finest tenors of his generation, Jonathon will thrill you with his stunning renditions of Secombe's greatest hits including *Love*, *This is My Song*, *Vienna City of My Dreams*, *Bless this House*, *Love is a Many Splendored Thing*, *I Believe* and his most popular signature song - *If I Ruled the World*, plus many more.

Having grown up in the '60s and '70s listening to the classical music his mother loved to play at home, Jonathon was greatly influenced by many of the wonderful operatic tenors popular during that time. Harry Secombe was a regular favourite.

"So many of the songs that I studied as a young tenor were the great ballads and pop hits that Harry Secombe made famous, and I always dreamt that one day I would be able to sing them with the beautiful phrasing, expression and brilliant tone that he always imbued in his recordings," Jonathon said.

He is thrilled to bring this heart-warming and touching tribute to one of his idols to the stage. His show will be packed with interesting stories about Secombe's life and stunning renditions of the singers' greatest hits on **Wednesday 23 February at 11am**.

INFRARED HEARING SYSTEM

An Infrared Hearing Assistance system is provided in the Concert Hall for patrons who require hearing assistance. Please advise ticketing staff at the time of ticket purchase if you require this service.

MOBILITY ASSISTANCE

If you require mobility assistance please advise the Box Office so your needs can be accommodated, for example if you require end of row seating, need to avoid stairs or require wheelchair seating. There is lift access to Level 2 in the Concert Hall. Wheelchair seating can be provided on the upper and middle sections of the Concert Hall in rows E and R.

ACCESSIBLE PARKING

There are two accessible parking spaces located at the front of the Centre on Middle Street and two in the patrons' car park at the rear of the Concert Hall. There is also a curb-side drop off point located to the right as you enter the patrons' car park.

PARKING

Parking is available at the rear of the Concert Hall accessible from Middle Street. The car park can fill up quickly so please allow plenty of time to park. If the car park is full, guests can be dropped off at the curb-side drop off point located to the right as you enter the patron car park. Alternatively, there is a public car park nearby between Doig and Waterloo Streets around 100 metres easy walking distance from the Centre.

CONCESSION POLICY

Proof of eligibility of concession must be presented to RPAC staff upon request when showing tickets to enter a performance. **Seniors** discounts apply only to holders of QLD Government Seniors cards or QLD Government Seniors Business Discount Cards. **Pensioner** discounts apply to holders of Centrelink Pension Cards and Veterans Affairs Repatriation Health Care Cards. Concession availability is at the discretion of the production promoter.
